

Eligibility Criteria To Appear For MEDPET - 2012

- 1) The candidate must be an Indian National.
- 2) Foreign / NRI Candidates seeking admission to PG Courses will have to obtain registration from MCI to be eligible.
- 3) The candidate must have passed MBBS examination from any Medical College recognised by the Medical Council of India.
- 4) The candidate must have completed the compulsory rotating internship on or before **30th April 2012**. He/She will have to produce a certificate of completion of internship before joining the course.
- 5) The candidate should possess a permanent registration with any State Medical Council in India or Medical Council of India. If he/she does not have the same he/she will be required to obtain such registration within one month after admission to the P.G. course, failing which his/her admission to P.G. course will be cancelled.
- 6) If a candidate does not fulfill any or all the above requirements or fails to pay the fees at the time of counselling, he/she will not be considered eligible for admission irrespective of his/her appearing for **MEDPET 2012** examination and securing a rank in the merit list.
- 7) The candidates possessing Diploma qualification in the same subject recognised by the Medical Council of India are eligible for exemption of 1st year of the 3 year residency (Post-Graduation Period) for P.G. course in the same subject.
