

Eligibility Criteria to Appear For DENPET 2012

- i) The candidate must be an Indian National.
- ii) The Candidate must have passed B.D.S. examination from a Dental College recognized by Dental Council of India.
- iii) The candidate must have completed one year compulsory rotating internship on or before 30-04-2012. He / She will have to produce a certificate of completion of internship before joining the course.
- iv) The candidate should possess a permanent registration with any State Dental Council or Dental Council of India. If the registration certificate is not submitted within one month after admission to the postgraduate course, admission to course will be cancelled.
- v) If a candidate does not fulfill any or all the above requirements or fails to pay the fees at the time of counseling, he/she will not be considered eligible for admission irrespective of his appearing for DENPET 2012 examination and securing a rank in the merit list.
- vi) Foreign Nationals seeking admission for the Post Graduate course in the institution must procure temporary registration by Dental Council of India for the duration of the Postgraduate training restricted to the Dental College to which he/she is admitted.
- vii) Candidates who have passed Post Graduate Diploma course recognised by the DCI, of the duration of 2 years in particular specialty will be eligible for admission in MDS in the same specialty and the duration of his/her MDS course will be 2 years.
