

## **Admission Procedure:**

1. The admissions to M.D.S. Course to the Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University Dental College will be made on the basis of merit obtained by the candidate in dental postgraduate entrance test i.e. DENPET-2012 and completing the eligibility conditions.
2. Eligibility: Please see ELIGIBILITY page.  
In case of candidates having equal marks in DENPET-2012 the following procedure shall be adopted as a tie-breaker:
  - i. First preference to the candidates on the basis of higher marks obtained in the final B.D.S. examination.
  - ii. In case of equal marks in (1) above, preference will be decided on grand total of marks secured by the candidate at I, II, III and final B.D.S. examinations.
  - iii. If equal, preference shall be decided on the basis of total marks secured by the candidate at the XII Std. examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects taken together.
  - iv. If equal, preference shall be decided on the basis of total marks obtained by the candidate in the XII Std. examination.
3. In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he has indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he shall be expelled from the educational institution
4. DENPET will be conducted at Centers in Pune, New Delhi, Navi Mumbai, Hyderabad and Vadodara on the addresses given on AT A GLANCE page.
5. The question paper of DENPET will contain 200 multiple choice questions.

For each question there is one correct or most appropriate answer out of 4 choices. The questions will be on the syllabi prescribed for the I,II,III and final B.D.S. examinations, with more weightage given to clinical subjects. Each correct answer will get 3 marks, there is no negative marking. No marks will be deducted for unanswered questions.
