4. A) Eligibility Criteria

a) A candidate who has passed final BHMS Examination with completion of one year compulsory rotatory internship or equivalent qualification in Homoeopathy included in Second Schedule to the HCC Act, 1973 (59).

b) Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery or equivalent qualification in Homoeopathy included in Second Schedule to the HCC Act, 1973 (59) undergoing a course of study of not less than 2 years duration (Graded degree)

c) A candidate who has completed 1 year compulsory rotatory internship or likely to complete the same on or before 31/05/2012 can appear for HOMPET 2011.

B) Eligibility for Appearing in HOMPET – 2012

i) The Candidate should be an Indian National.

ii) The Candidate must have passed BHMS examination with completion of one year compulsory rotatory internship from any Homoeopathic Medical College/ Institute recognized by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi for admission.

iii) The candidate must have completed the compulsory rotating internship of one year duration. He/she will be required to produce a certificate of completion of internship before joining the course.

iv) If a candidate does not fulfill any one or all the above requirements he/ she will not be considered eligible for admission irrespective of his appearing and securing a rank in the merit list.
